-Testing varies slightly as Recacril and Tempotest are tested in Europe while Sunbrella is tested in the U.S.

-Color Fastness for Recacril and Tempotest are on an 8 degree scale where 1 is "very poor" and 8 is "excellent."

-The water column indicates how many mm of water per cm² on the cloth can stand before the material is leaked.
